**29/01/2007 Goya Annual Awards –
Spanish National Academy of Fine Arts and Cinematography:**

The 21st Edition of the Goya Awards, that took place yesterday night, 28th of January, at the *Palacio Municipal de Congresos del Campo de las Naciones*, in Madrid, has awarded films released in Spain during the period 1st December 2005 – 30th November 2006. The films nominated in the category of **Best (Spanish) Film** were **Alatriste**, produced by Estudios Picasso, Origen P.C. S.A., NBC Universal Global Networks España S.L., **El Laberinto del Fauno** (Estudios Picasso, Tequila Gang, Esperanto Filmoi), **Salvador** (MediaPro, Future Films) and **Volver (El Deseo DA, S.L.U)**. The winner was *Volver*, by Pedro Almodóvar, with MEDIA Distribution support. The nominated films *El laberinto del Fauno*, Spanish-mexican coproduction and **Salvador**, by Manuel Hueriga (MEDIA Development), have been as well financed by the MEDIA Programme.

With regard to the nominated for **Best European Film**, the candidates were **Copying Beethoven** (UK), **The Wind that Shakes the Barley**, coproduction of Germany, Ireland, Italy, UK and Spain, financed likewise by MEDIA (Distribution and Development), **Scoop**, UK, by Woody Allen and the British movie and winner: **The Queen**, by Stephen Frears.
